

Recording Music for Church Activities

Sunday Services, Choir/Band Performances & Wedding Videos



Do you record music in your church activities?

If so, you must first ensure that you have obtained permission.

Today's technology has made creating your own music recordings easier than ever before. With licences from CCLI, you can audio/video record church services, record your own CDs or over-dub pre-recorded music onto wedding videos.



**There are three licence options available:
Each is specific to the type of recording
you wish to make:**

**1 Audio/Video Record Music
from your Church Services**

There may be occasions when you would like to record your worship services for those not able to attend, perhaps because they are housebound or involved in leading other groups.

Licence: The Church Copyright Licence (CCL)

With the CCL you can:

- Audio/video-record live music from your worship services.
- Charge for your recordings.

NB: There are limits to the number of copies you can make and the amount you can charge per copy. Please visit www.ccli.co.uk/recording-music for details.

Licence Fees

Licence fees are based on the number of people attending your main service. If you already hold a licence from CCLI any additional licences you purchase will be charged at a pro-rated fee in order to match the expiry date of your existing licence(s). **2 Audio/Video Record Music for
Sale to your Community**

As an agent to the Mechanical-Copyright Protection Society (MCPS), CCLI can provide churches with a licence to record music onto any physical format (CD, Cassette, DVD or Video) for sale to the general public.

Licence: The Limited Manufacture Licence (LML)



With the LML you can:

- Record music (live or studio) included in the MCPS repertoire (Christian and secular).
- Duplicate up to 1,000 copies of any recording for sale to your church or local community (maximum of 2,500 units per licensee per year).

There are limits to the number of works that you can include on each recording. Please refer to the licence terms and conditions available on request or from www.ccli.co.uk/recording-music

3 Record Music for Wedding Videos

If you permit the use of audio/video equipment to record music at wedding services in your church then CCLI recommends that you ask the wedding couple or professional videographer to obtain a Wedding Video-Recording Licence (WVRL), especially if they are not church members.
